

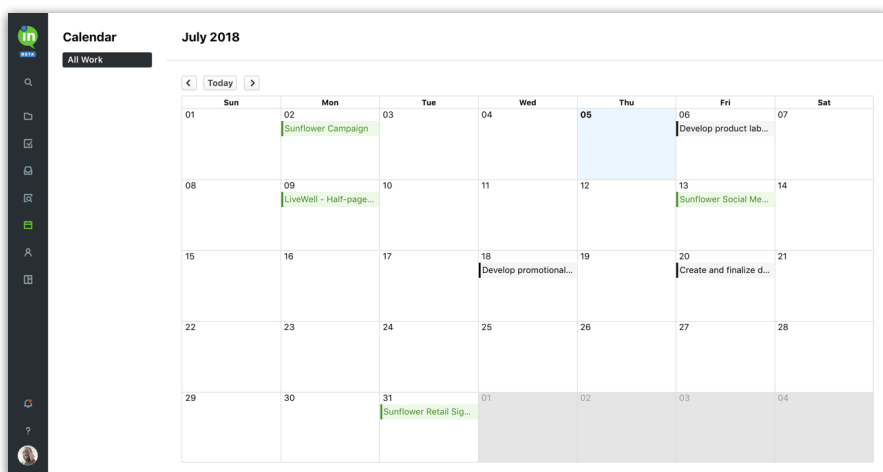

New Features

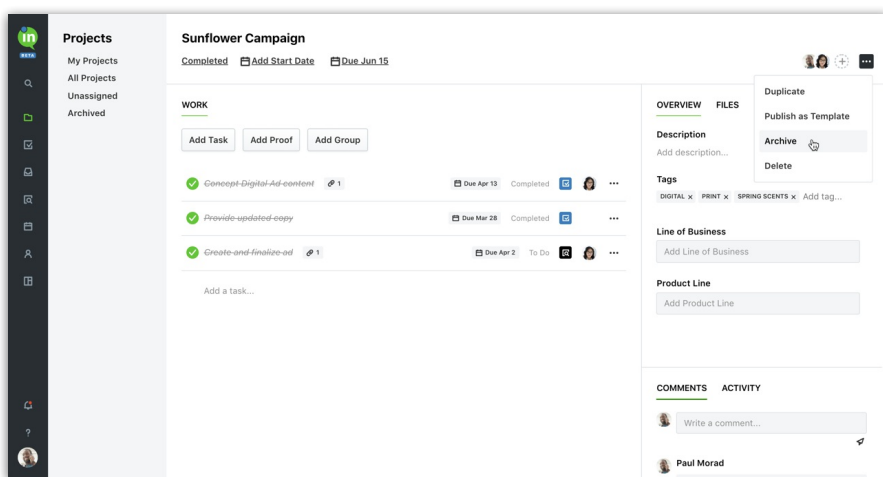
Calendar

Now team members have more visibility into work that is due! Any project, task, or proof with a due date will now appear within a month-by-month calendar view. Better yet, you can click directly into work to get more info and make updates on the fly.



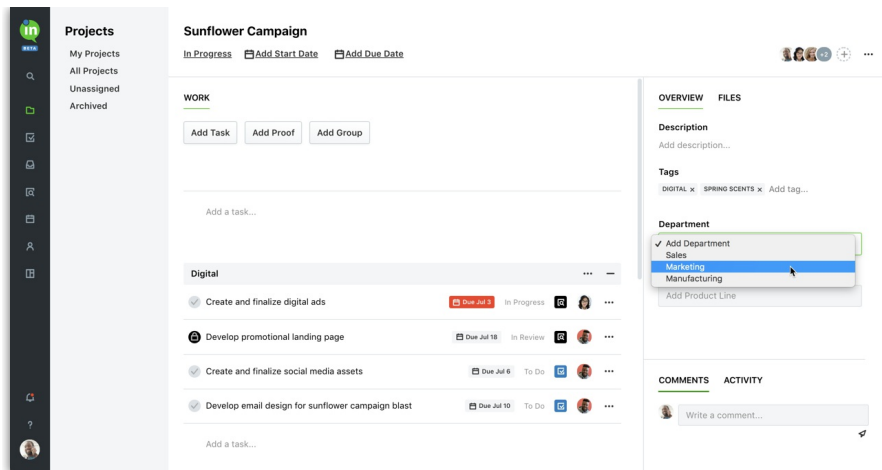
Archiving

Clean up old projects, tasks, and proofs throughout the system by archiving them! Archived work is still accessible throughout the system (even in search!) but will no longer appear in active workspaces.



Custom Dropdown Fields

Quickly add the data you need to projects with the new Custom Dropdown Field type! Any time you'd like your team to choose from a pre-defined list of options, you can create a new custom dropdown field that can be updated within the project. This could help keep track of project type, brand, or additional options specific to your team projects!

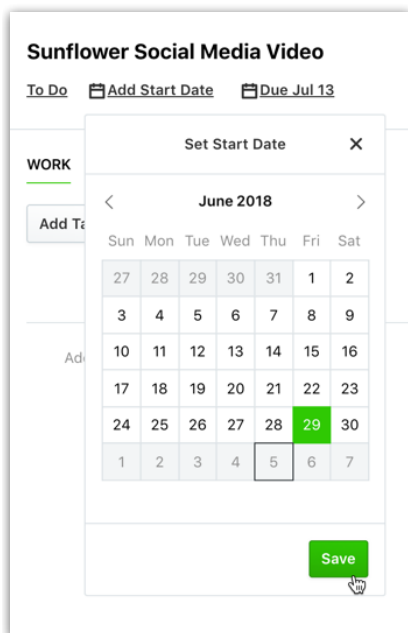


Search: Custom Fields
